- Clued up on writing funding bids or large funding bodies, experience in helping grow charities, sponsorships and fundraising strategy.
- Clued up on accounts, book-keeping and budgeting for charities and CICs, with a good understanding of financial and business strategy
- Clued up on local youth culture, willing to learn and share.
- A reliable person who is connected to Manchester/Greater Manchester.
- Ideally 5-10+ years experience in their field (excluding youth trustee).
